Based on our review conducted and procedure performed as stated above and based on the consideration of the review reports of other auditors referred to in paragraph 6 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with applicable Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies, Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other recognized accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
- 6. We did not review the interim financial information/results of the GCPL, whose interim financial information/results reflects total revenue of ₹8,841.90 lakhs and ₹20,572.68 lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended 31st December, 2021 respectively, total net profit after tax of ₹256.69 lakhs and ₹446.64 lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended 31st December, 2021 respectively, total comprehensive income of ₹258.68 lakhs and ₹445.39 lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended 31st December, 2021 respectively as considered in the Statement.

The Statement also includes the Parent's share of net profit of ₹ 8.04 lakhs and ₹ 82.52 lakhs for the quarter and nine month ended 31st December, 2021 respectively and total comprehensive income of ₹ 9.28 lakhs and ₹ 84.50 lakhs for the quarter and nine month ended 31st December, 2021 respectively, in respect of the Joint Venture Company. The interim financial information/results of the Joint venture Company in Bangladesh has been restated by the management of the Parent in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under section 133 of the Act read with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015, as amended and other accounting principles generally accepted in India based on reviewed interim financial information/results and report thereon of other auditors which were prepared following Accounting Standards and Generally Accepted Accounting Practices prevalent in Bangladesh. We have reviewed the restated information/ results.

The interim financial information/results of the GCPL and Joint Venture Company have been reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of the GCPL and Joint Venture Company are based solely on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.

Our opinion on the Statement is not modified in respect of these matters.
