Belgium confirms Choksi's arrest, extradition request

New Delhi, Mumbai, April 14

THE BELGIAN GOVERNMENT on Monday confirmed that fugitive jeweller Mehul Choksi has been arrested in Antwerp following an extradition request by Indian investigation agencies. Wanted for his alleged involvement in the ₹13,000-crore Punjab National Bank (PNB) loan fraud case, Choksi, 65, fled India in January 2018.

"The Belgian Federal Public Service of Justice can confirm that Mr Mehul Choksi was arrested on Saturday, April 12, 2025. He is being detained in anticipation of further judicial proceedings. Access to his legal counsel has been assured," a spokesperson of the Belgian Ministry of Justice told IE.

"Finally, the Belgian Federal Public Service of Justice can confirm that the Indian authorities have introduced an extradition request for Mr Choksi," the spokesperson said, adding that no further details can be released at this stage.

spokesperson of the Antwerp police confirmed that they had successfully executed the arrest warrant. The action "concerns an arrest ordered by the international service, Antwerp Public Prosecutor's Office, following the service of an extradition procedure and the decision declaring a foreign arrest warrant enforceable," the spokesperson said.

India and Belgium have a long-standing extradition treaty. "Following his detention on Saturday, a team of

three to four senior officials of CBI have been asked to travel to Belgium to complete all the procedures and documentation work," said sources.

Confirming Choksi's arrest, his lawyer, Vijay Aggarwal, said they are in the process of filing an appeal. "Our appeal seeking his release on bail will mainly be on the ground of his medical condition, he is undergoing treatment for cancer. We will also be arguing that he is not a flight risk," Aggarwal said.

He said the case can come

up for hearing only after five days, which is when they will be filing the appeal for bail. "At the moment, he is in prison and there (Belgium), the procedure is not to apply for bail but file an appeal. During that appeal, request is made that he should not be kept in detention and he should be permitted to defend himself and oppose the extradition request while not being in custody," Aggarwal said. He said their legal defence would be that this is a "political case and the human condition (in Indian prisons) was not good".

Choksi, his nephew and fugitive diamond merchant Nirav Modi, and their family members were among those booked by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and Enforcement Directorate (ED) in 2018 for perpetrating the alleged loan fraud at PNB's Brady House branch in Mumbai.

Nirav Modi, declared a fugitive economic offender, has been lodged in a London jail since he was held by the authorities there in 2019 on the basis of a legal request made by the ED and the CBI. He is contesting extradition to India.

Power production doubled in 10 years: PM

PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA Modi on Monday said there were blackouts under the Congress rule before 2014, but power production has doubled in the last decade and India is now exporting electricity.

Addressing a gathering after laying the foundation stone of an 800-MW ultra-supercritical modern thermal power unit at the Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram Thermal Power Plant, Modi said Haryana is seeing "double speed" of the BJP's double-engine government.



The thermal power unit, spread across 233 acre and worth around Rs 8,470 crore, is expected to become operational by March 2029. It will

significantly boost Haryana's energy self-sufficiency and provide uninterrupted power supply across the state.

Earlier, state-owned BHEL had bagged the order to set up an 800 MW plant which will be Haryana's first ultra-supercritical technology-based power project. The unit shall be established adjacent to the existing 2x300 MW units, currently operational at Yamunanagar.

Taking forward the vision of 'Gobardhan' (Galvanising Organic Bio-Agro Resources

Dhan), Modi also laid the foundation stone of a compressed biogas plant in Mukarabpur.

The plant, slated for completion by 2027, will have an annual production capacity of 2,600 tonne and will help in effective organic waste management while contributing to clean energy production and environmental conservation, a statement said.

Modi also digitally inaugurated the 14.4-km Rewari Bypass project under the Bharatmala Pariyojana.

311 kg of meth seized off Gujarat coast, says ATS

THE GUJARAT ANTI Terrorist Squad (ATS) and the Indian Coast Guard (ICG), in a joint operation, seized 311 kg of methamphetamine, also known as crystal meth or ice, which was dumped into the Arabian Sea by smugglers from fleeing across the international maritime boundary line (IMBL), officials said on Monday.

ATS officers said the final destination of the consignment, worth approximately

₹1,800 crore, was Tamil Nadu.

The operation took place on the intervening night of Saturday and Sunday. The smugglers dumped the consignment in Indian waters about 2 nautical miles from the IMBL after a Coast Guard vessel spotted their boat and tried to intercept it. After dumping the consignment, the boat managed to cross the IMBL into Pakistan's maritime domain, officials said.

At a press conference on Monday, ATS DIG Sunil Joshi said his team had received a tip-off on April 10

that a handover of about 400 kg narcotics was to take place on the Indian side of the IMBL off the Gujarat coastline on the intervening night of April 12 and 13. This information was shared with the Coast Guard.

The boat to receive the consignment was to arrive at the spot from Tamil Nadu, the final destination of the illegal consignment, said DIG Joshi. As many as 311 sealed waterproof packets, each containing one kilogramme of methamphetamine, were recovered from the sea, officials said.

Mumbai water tanker strike called off

IN A RELIEF for Mumbaiers battling hot summer and water woes, tanker operators on Monday withdrew their strike on its fifth day following the invocation of the Disaster Management Act by the civic body to requisition private water tankers and wells a day before. The association announced the immediate resumption of the water supply. The breakthrough came after a meeting between municipal commissioner Bhushan Gagrani and Mumbai Water Tanker Association members earlier in the day.

Waqf violence shifts to Bhangar, Murshidabad remains calm

FRESH EPISODES OF Waqf (Amendment) Act-related violence rocked Bhangar area in West Bengal's South 24 Parganas district on Monday, even as police claimed that law and order situation in the previous riot epicentre of Murshidabad remained largely under control.

Supporters of the Indian Secular Front (ISF) clashed with the police at Bhangar during protests over the Act, leading to several injuries, vandalising of public properties and the torching of multiple police vehicles.

The clashes erupted when police stopped ISF supporters from heading towards Ramliha Maidan in central Kolkata to attend an anti-Waqf Act rally addressed by party leader and Bhangar MLA Naushad Siddique. According to police, the rallyists were stopped near Bhojherhat on the Basanti Highway, where a large number of ISF workers had gathered from Bhangar as well as neighbouring areas such as Minakhan and Sandeshkhali.

Tension escalated when the crowd attempted to break through police barricades, leading to a clash between the two sides. "Some police vehicles were set on fire by the protesters and a few police personnel were injured when the agitators attacked the law enforcers," a senior police officer said.

Eyewitnesses said police resorted to lathi-charge to disperse the protesters, as the rally at Ramliha Ground didn't have proper police permission, leading to at least one ISF worker sustaining a head injury.

The situation spiralled quickly, prompting ISF activists to sit on a protest on the highway, leading to long traffic

snarls along the stretch. A large police force, including senior officers, was deployed to bring the situation under control. The protesters were later dispersed. Opposition parties alleged that police did little to stop the rampaging mob. Addressing the gathering in Kolkata, Siddique said, "This law is not just an attack on Muslims, it is an assault on the Constitution. We won't accept this Act. The government that supports such laws must go," he said.

Earlier in the day, senior Border Security Force (BSF) officials visited the violence-hit areas of Murshidabad, assuring residents of all necessary assistance to restore peace and ensure their safety.

The BSF delegation led by Additional Director General (East) Ravi Gandhi visited the disturbed pockets in Suti, Samserganj and Dhulian that witnessed widespread unrest over the weekend, claiming the lives of at least three people and leaving many injured.

States can't refuse to implement Waqf law: BJP

STATES CANNOT REFUSE to implement the Waqf Amendment Act, the BJP asserted on Monday citing constitutional provisions, and slammed the Congress and other INDIA bloc constituents over their continued opposition to the law.

The assertions came after Jharkhand Mukti Morcha (JMM) MLA and state minister Hafizul Hassan reportedly said that, to him, Sharia came first and then the Constitution, while Karnataka minister BZ Zameer Ahmed Khan claimed the law would not be implemented in the state. On Saturday, chief minister Mamata Banerjee had also said the Act would not be implemented in West Bengal.

Asked for comment, BJP national spokesperson Sudhanshu Trivedi described their stance on the issue as 'a matter of serious concern' and said they made it clear with their remarks that the Constitution would be in danger if their parties continued to remain in power. He also termed their remarks an insult to BR Ambedkar, the chief architect of the Constitution.

"We want to make it clear that after the 73rd and the 74th amendments in the Constitution, powers of the Centre, state and district-level governments are clearly defined. No district panchayat can go beyond the law passed by the state assembly and no state can bypass the law passed by the Centre (Parliament)," the BJP Rajya Sabha MP said.
